ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION WEEKEND

Friday 26th – Sunday 28th October 2012

The Cecilian Society, University of Glasgow was formed on 18th October 1952, with the aim of "furtherance of interest in music, particularly within the student body of the University of Glasgow." Alongside lectures and concert trips, the society quickly expanded into performing and our first opera in 1955, Gilbert & Sullivan's *The Pirates of Penzance*, paved the way for the spectacular productions of music theatre for which the society is known. The Society is made up of more than just those who tread the boards, however, and over the last six decades has seen any number of choirs, concert parties, folk groups, contemporary music ensembles, technical crew and orchestral musicians among its number. Whatever brought these people together, and whatever talents they may have brought with them (or discovered once they came), these people all shared the Society's aim of having fun through music – and have fun they did. Wherever Cecilian alumni are gathered together (and they are often unearthed in the most unusual of places), tales will be told well into the small hours of the morning: the only thing more famed than the Cecilian concert is the Cecilian party.

And of course it's only fitting that a Cecilian party is thrown to celebrate our 60^{th} birthday. We will be holding a number of events over the course of the weekend $26^{th} - 28^{th}$ October 2012, and we hope that as many Cecilians as possible, young and old, will be able to come and take part in what promises to be an extremely memorable weekend: to help us celebrate all that we have achieved in the last 60 years, reminisce over good times past, and look forward to good times future whilst, no doubt, having a few good times in the present.

CELEBRATION WEEKEND

Friday 26th October

The celebrations begin on Friday evening with a birthday ceilidh. There will be a chance to catch up with other Cecilians from your era in relaxed surroundings as well as finding out what is happening in the Cecilian Society of 2012. A light buffet will be provided and at its centrepiece, of course, a large birthday cake. Following the reunions, the food and drink will continue whilst a ceilidh band strikes up to get the party going.

Saturday 27th October

For those of you who wish to take an active part in Sunday evening's concert, rehearsals will begin on the University campus on Saturday morning and continue throughout Saturday and Sunday. Plenty of time will be made available for those of you who have left the area to discover the changes in Glasgow's west end at your leisure. Saturday evening is given over to a relaxed karaoke — an excellent opportunity for a drink with the current membership or the chance to catch up with long-lost friends.

Sunday 28th October

Sunday evening will form the focus of our birthday celebrations. A specially formed chorus of Cecilian members past and present will present a concert encapsulating the spirit of 60 years of Cecilian history, featuring a wide variety of musical styles and tastes – something for everyone.

Once the concert has concluded, there will be a brief interlude to allow for costume changes, after which we will convene for a formal dinner to conclude the weekend's festivities. After this, who knows where the Cecilian party will take us!

For those of you who have moved away from the area, accommodation will be available at discounted rates in the hotel where we will be dining, although there is a large selection of other accommodation nearby if this is not to your taste.
